



DR. ELIZABETH MARY LUTAS



Elizabeth Mary Lutas was born to Maria and Michael Lutas ---poor immigrants from Carpatho Rus in Eastern Europe.

She received a bachelor of Arts degree from New York University in 1972, majoring in Chemistry and French. She graduated from New York University as a Doctor of Medicine wit honor in 1976. Her training in internal Medicine was at NYU Medical Center, which included Bellevue Hospital,

and Cardiology training was at NYU Medical Center and at the Cornell- New York Hospital.

She wanted to be a doctor all her life, specifically to work with the poor. Several years after completing her training, the problems of our homeless brothers and sisters emerged, and she have ministered to the homeless and poor throughout her medical career and continues to do so. She worked in homeless shelter for 23 years through Saint Vincent's Hospital. Clinics and medical care were brought to the shelters. She worked in about 12 shelters during these years, helping to set up some of the clinic as well. As quiet acknowledgement—of Dr. Luas's dedication to the homeless, one of the young doctors she had mentored for nearly two years and who was with her as she cared for patients once said to her. "Dr. Lutas, you are the wealthiest person in the world, and she answered "I know, Yan Yi, I know.

She was a first responder on 9/11, volunteering to go down to the site after the first building fell and was there when the second building fell. She was in charge of Triage when the first-line staging hospital was set up with FEMA – and later, both the Triage Unit and the Medical Unit. Those who were injured at the World Trade Center site were brought there first.

She still works in a clinic for the homeless run by Sunriver Health. Vans go around Queens to shelters and bring our homeless brothers and sisters to the clinic, where she receives a great deal of love and joy from here patients and, most importantly, from God.

She also has her church – Saint Teresa Church in Woodside, where she volunteers as an Eucharistic Minister, Lector, weekday Sacristan, and teacher. She established and ran an overnight homeless shelter at the parish from 1996 to 2009. She is in her 53rd year of teaching religion to the young ones who go to public school. For 20 years, she taught in Saint Teresa School, coming in each year to teach about the human body – a different system to each grade. She has spoken at Confirmations retreats, to RCIA classes, and to church ministers.
